

Noun (संज्ञा)

Singular to plural:

Rule 1 If there are following letters s, ss, ch, sh, x, and o in the end of any noun. Add "es" to make plural.

For instance- (पुलिंग्दा) Truss - Trusses

(दलदल) Marsh - Marshes

Mango - Mangoes

Bus - Buses

Exception - Photo - Photos

Piano - Pianos

Halo - Halos

Rule 2 If there is 'F' or 'Fe' in the end of any noun, removing it and add 'ves' to make plural noun.

For example- Wife - wives

Knife - Knives

Thief - Thieves

Exception- Roof - Roofs

Chief - Chiefs

Rule 3 If there is 'Y' with consonant in the end of any noun removing it add 'ies' to make plural.

For example- Story - Stories

Army - Armies

Puppy - Puppies

Rule 4 There are some nouns that do not follow any rule.

For example- Child - children

Man - Men

Foot - Feet

Tooth - Teeth

Person - People

Rule 5 There are some nouns which are used in the singular and plural form.

For example- Hair - 1. Her **hair** is dark. (Ordinary used)

1. There are only three grey hairs on my head now.(Countable use)
