

PREPOSITION

Definition: - The word that is used to show place, time, direction, motion etc.

Correct use of preposition (upon)

'upon' is used to show particular motion but an action is confined from one medium to another

Example:-

Mohan fell upon the ground from the roof.

Explanation-

(change of medium from roof to ground)

The books fell upon the ground

There are some verbs that follow preposition "upon"

Some of them have been given below it -

1. Reflect: -- rays reflect upon the glass. (to throw the light)
2. Look: -- he looks upon the god. (to consider)
3. Impose: -- yarn of Rakhi is impose upon love. (restriction)
4. Prey: -- They preyed upon him. (to kill)
